

Paper plan launcher

Paper Elastic
Cardboard Toothpick
Paperclip



Fold and make a paper airplane. (I folded inward twice, then once on the outside to make a long sleek jet.)



At approximately 2 inches from the point, open your airplane and make a small hole with the toothpick on the middle crease.



Bend open one side of a paperclip to a straight line and bend backwards to make an 'S' shape (sort of). Poke the bent curve into the hole on the plane making sure the end points toward the back. The rest of the clip will be on the inside.



Fold the top of the plane closed and tape. It will hold the paperclip in place.



Fold the piece of cardboard in half. Put an elastic over the cardboard and fold over and tape the cardboard together. Loop the elastic on the paperclip hook at the bottom of the plane. Stretch the plane back and let go!
