

# TORN PAPER ANIMAL ART INSTRUCTIONS

**You will receive a 'half' piece of foam poster board and magazine pages. You will need a glue stick and a few markers from home.**



Take out pages from a magazine (you can use any thin paper with a design, ex. scrap-booking paper), and tear into strips. Decide if you want mixed vibrant colors or want to stay within a color scheme, and choose the pages that have those colors in them.



Start gluing the strips of paper, fanning them out from the center like a star burst. Glue each strip down as you go. Overlap to help cover the background foam board.



Once you have glued down all your strips, let them dry for a little bit, then you will be ready to draw on the eyes and mouth/beak with a sharpie. You can draw as much of these shapes as you want, color in the eyes with a sharpie (leaving a small white spot in each eye to look like the light is reflecting off it), or you can paint them.



Turn it into a bird or cat or whatever you imagine!
